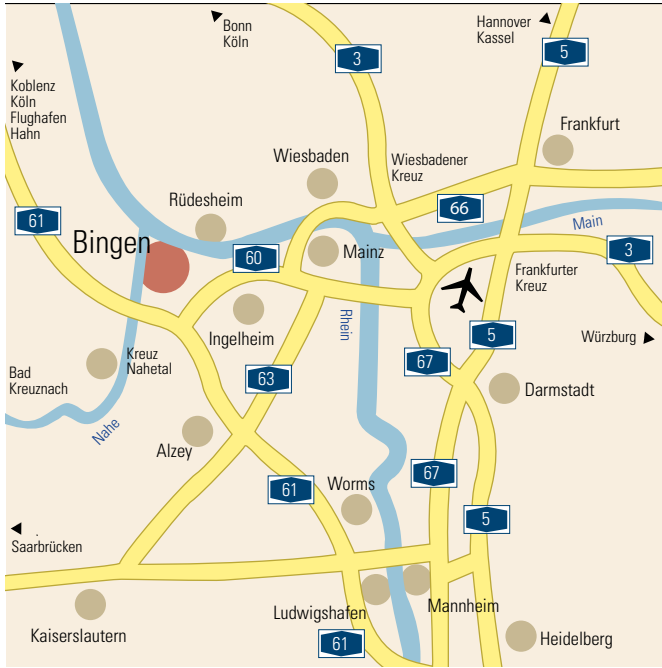


## How to find us



Coming from Mainz/Airport Frankfurt/Main via the **A60**, take the exit "Bingen-Ost/Zentrum". Follow the signs marked "Zentrum". After you have passed one traffic circle and one major intersection, you can relax and follow this street for about three km.

When you see a VW/Skoda car dealer to your right, you should be attentive again. Shortly after that, the street will bend first to the right and then to the left again. After only one hundred meters, you should turn left into the "Bahnhofstraße". Stay alert, as you should turn left again immediately after the intersection. There you will find our parking lot.

Coming from Koblenz/Airport Frankfurt-Hahn via the **A61**, take the exit Nr. 49 "Bingen-Mitte" and head for the Bundesstraße B9 direction "Bingerbrück/St. Goar". Follow the course of the road until you reach Bingen-Bingerbrück. At the first intersection with traffic lights, turn right, direction "Bingen-Zentrum". Follow the road until you cross the bridge over the river Nahe.

After some 300 meters you will reach a traffic circle. Keep straight on and follow the street until you see the train station "Bingen (Rhein) Stadt" to the left. When you reach the train station building, you should turn right into the "Bahnhofstraße". Immediately after the intersection

you should turn left again to find our parking lot.

Coming from Ludwigshafen via the **A61**, you should also take exit Nr. 49 "Bingen-Mitte" and then follow the description for travelers from Koblenz.

You can find **free parking space** at our company parking lot, please use only those lots marked "Viprinet". Further – charged-for – parking space can be found in the Bahnhofstraße and the Mainzer Straße.

## How to find us

**Coming by train**, you can comfortably get off at “Bingen (Rhein) Stadt” train station. Opposite the station building, you can walk up the Bahnhofstraße for one hundred meters. Turn left at the top of the street and you will already be in front of building Nr. 43. You will find our company headquarter in the first floor.

Please note that long-distance trains will only stop at the train station “Bingen (Rhein) Hbf” located in the district Bingen-Bingerbrück. Here you can change into the local train “TransRegio” to go to the station “Bingen (Rhein) Stadt”.

For airline travelers, Bingen is well connected to the airports Frankfurt/Main and Frankfurt-Hahn. With a distance of some 60 kilometers from each of the airports, the city is located right in the middle between them.

While Frankfurt-Hahn is used by Ryanair and other low-cost carriers, long distance travelers will usually arrive at Frankfurt/Main.

**From the airport Frankfurt/Main**, you can reach Bingen by car following the highways A3/A67/A60, heading for

Mainz and Koblenz. For the detailed route into the city, please follow the instructions for travelers by car.

By train, you may reach Bingen best with local trains. Therefore use the Frankfurt Airport regional train station, not the long-distance train station. Take a train to Mainz and change there to a “TransRegio” train that will bring to straight to Bingen (Rhein) Stadt. From there it is only a short walk to our company headquarters (see above).

**The airport Frankfurt-Hahn** is not yet connected by train. You have the chance to reach Bingen with an hourly bus with change in Simmern (departing at bus terminal 2). Its long journey time and a somewhat tricky connection in Simmern make this option not very advisable. Taking the bus to Mainz and there changing to a local train to Bingen is also possible, but it is as tedious and intricate.

We therefore recommend driving to Bingen with a rental car. Take the state road B45 to “Simmern/Rheinböllen”. In Rheinböllen you can reach the highway A61, direction Ludwigshafen/Mainz. Follow the road to Bingen and then use the instructions for travelers by car from Koblenz.
